# *More Good News!* – RCG has been awarded an innovation grant!

The RCG Grade 4/5 Team is very excited to have received a \$5000 grant from the Langley School District for Innovative use of Technology. We are going to be investigating alternate sources of energy to power school iPads – we will be learning about solar energy through the use of solar panels, and generating power through the use of under-desk pedal-powered generators. We will be inquiring into how much money a school could save by using solar and student energy to charge devices (rather than just "plugging them in"), with a goal of reporting out to the school community and the Langley District with our findings. This is a two-year project, and we can't wait to get started!

# **Reunification Drill**

Next week, Wednesday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, our school will be holding another regular scheduled emergency drill. We do these throughout the year, Fire, Earthquake and Lock Down drills.

Next week will be a little different as we will be practicing an Earthquake drill, however our grade 2 classrooms will practice the reunification process that we would do for the whole school in a real emergency. This will take place from about 2pm to the end of the day. If you see something going on on the playing fields, you will know what we are doing. We thank the grade 2 teachers and parents for their cooperation and planning. We will learn valuable information from this that we can use to better prepare in the event of a real emergency. **Sports Day** is this **Friday**, **June 9**<sup>th</sup>. This is always an exciting day for students. RCG families are welcome to come and watch their children compete in their house teams in the different events. We will start the day with a **"Wheels Parade"**. Students are encouraged to decorate <u>anything</u> with wheels (scooter, bike, skateboard, RC Car etc.), in their house colour and join the parade at the start Sports Day. This will also earn points for their team! <u>We will organize them in the gym prior to the start of the day</u>. The morning will have stations and events on the field and gym.

\*Note - The afternoon will give choice to younger Primary classes to be in their class for a calm afternoon, or come and watch intermediate Tug-o-Wars on the playing field.

\*Lunch and snacks are still as normal on this day, so please ensure students come prepared for a full day.

Weather is always a hot topic come sports day. If the day is a 'rain out' we will not be rescheduling. If it is a hot day, we ask that students come with sunscreen and a hat to reduce fatigue. Sending your child with a bottle of water would be an excellent idea as well. The weather does look to be warm and sunny. We hope to see you there, Go Team!
